



Biocide, Disinfectant, Sterilant and Sanitizing Agent

12G Pack:

Makes 31 gallons of ready to use disinfectant.

Directions:

1. Remove inner packet from foil pouch and put the pack in a 5 gallon bucket or other 5 gallon container filled with clean water. This will make your concentrated solution.

Gallon Ready-To-Use:

In order to make gallons of ready to use solution measure 20 oz. of concentrate you made in the 5 gallon container into a clean gallon jug and fill with water. Begin using product.

Quart Ready-To-Use:

In order to make quarts of ready to use solution measure 5 oz. of the concentrate you made in the 5 gallon container into a clean quart bottle and fill with water. Begin using product.

5G Pack

Makes 13 gallons of ready to use disinfectant.

Directions:

1. Remove inner packet from foil pouch and put the pack in a 1 gallon jug or other 1 gallon container filled with clean water. This will make your concentrated solution.

Gallon Ready-To-Use:

In order to make gallons of ready to use solution measure 10 oz. of the concentrate you made in the 1 gallon container into a clean gallon jug and fill with water. Begin using product.

Quart Ready-To-Use:

In order to make quarts of ready to use solution measure 2.5 oz. of the concentrate you made in the 1 gallon container into a clean gallon jug and fill with water. Begin using product.

Tip:

Rinse out and use a 20 oz. pop bottle for easy and convenient measuring. Measurements do not have to be exact.

1G Pack

Makes 2.6 gallons of ready to use disinfectant.

1. Remove inner packet from foil pouch and put the pack in a 1 gallon jug or other 1 gallon container filled with clean water. This will make concentrate. Add 1.5 times the amount of water to the concentrate to make RTU. (Example: 1 quart of concentrate makes 2.5 qts of RTU solution.)
